These special visitors will need host families to house two children together from Friday October 15 * Wednesday October 20. In addition to meals and housing, you would be responsible

for driving the kids to St. Hubert each day and picking them up again in the afternoon. While they are here, these children will perform in a Guatemalan instrument orchestra and will be visiting the classrooms. They perform for the parish and will be present at all Masses that weekend for you to meet and/or sponsor.
