

CODE OF CONDUCT - Pre-school – Grades 1-3

I will take turns and include others in activities.

I will tell an adult when someone is being hurt or there is an emergency.

I will tell an adult when I am being hurt.

I will respect others' property and space.

I will be a good listener and not interrupt.

I will obey school/parish rules and respect the adults who watch over me.

I will not use bad language or tease others.
