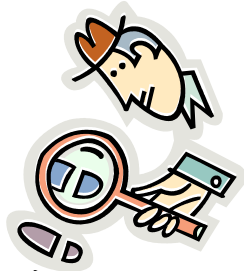


Calling All CSI Agents Entering Grades 4 & 5!
