Twins Prints from the inaugural game at Target Field - Ben introduced two prints from the MN Twins Inaugural game at the new Target Field. The prints are of the first pitch and the other is the game opening ceremony with the American Flag. The prints are being sold at places such as Dick's Sports at a price beginning at \$150.00. Ben proposed taking orders for the prints and offering them for purchase to SHS community with 100% of the profits going towards the SHS Hornet Club. Members of the Hornet Club will research the idea to see if the two prints can be offered for sale at SHS. Also, members will check to see if the two prints can be on display at SHS. Flyers will be created and distributed to the families who expressed an interest in the SHS Day at the Twins game on June 9th.

Lynn will distribute the tickets to the families beginning Monday May 18th. Next year there will be more tickets available for purchase.

Casino Night - looking for a date to have the event and a time that the rooms will be available. The intent is to have Casino Night replace the Back to School Dance. We are planning to have Casino Night in mid to late October with the intent of bringing higher attendance of the SHS community.

St. Hubert's Spirit wear:

1. New Spirit Wear order forms were presented for the specific sports. The order form is an abbreviated form offering the following items: sport specific shirts, SHS logo water bottles, string back packs and large SHS logo duffle bags.
2. Spirit Wear orders can be placed at the Donald's Uniform Sales August 3rd and the items will be available for pick up at the 2010-2011 Meet and Greet on August 31st.
 - a. Middle School Sweat Shirts will be available to try on and purchased during this event.
 - b. Wind shirts and wicking/sports shirts with SHS logo will be on display and orders will be taken.

3. Spirit Wear order forms will be included in student informational packages which are mailed out to the SHS families during the summer.

Vending machines/Concessions:

1. Erin and Laura have taken over as the Vending Machine Coordinators. The transition is going smoothly.
2. The inventories for Vending Machines and the Concessions now have separate storage locations.
3. Mobile Vending Stand
 - a. More research is needed before a mobile stand can be purchased.
 - b. Location of the mobile stand during games is still being reviewed as there are several options. Some locations offer more food options such as pizza and/or hot dogs. Others either block entry ways or the view of game for the concession's volunteer workers.
4. Optional venues for concessions: Eighth grade play, volleyball tournaments. These events have solid dates that allow for coordination of volunteers and supplies.
